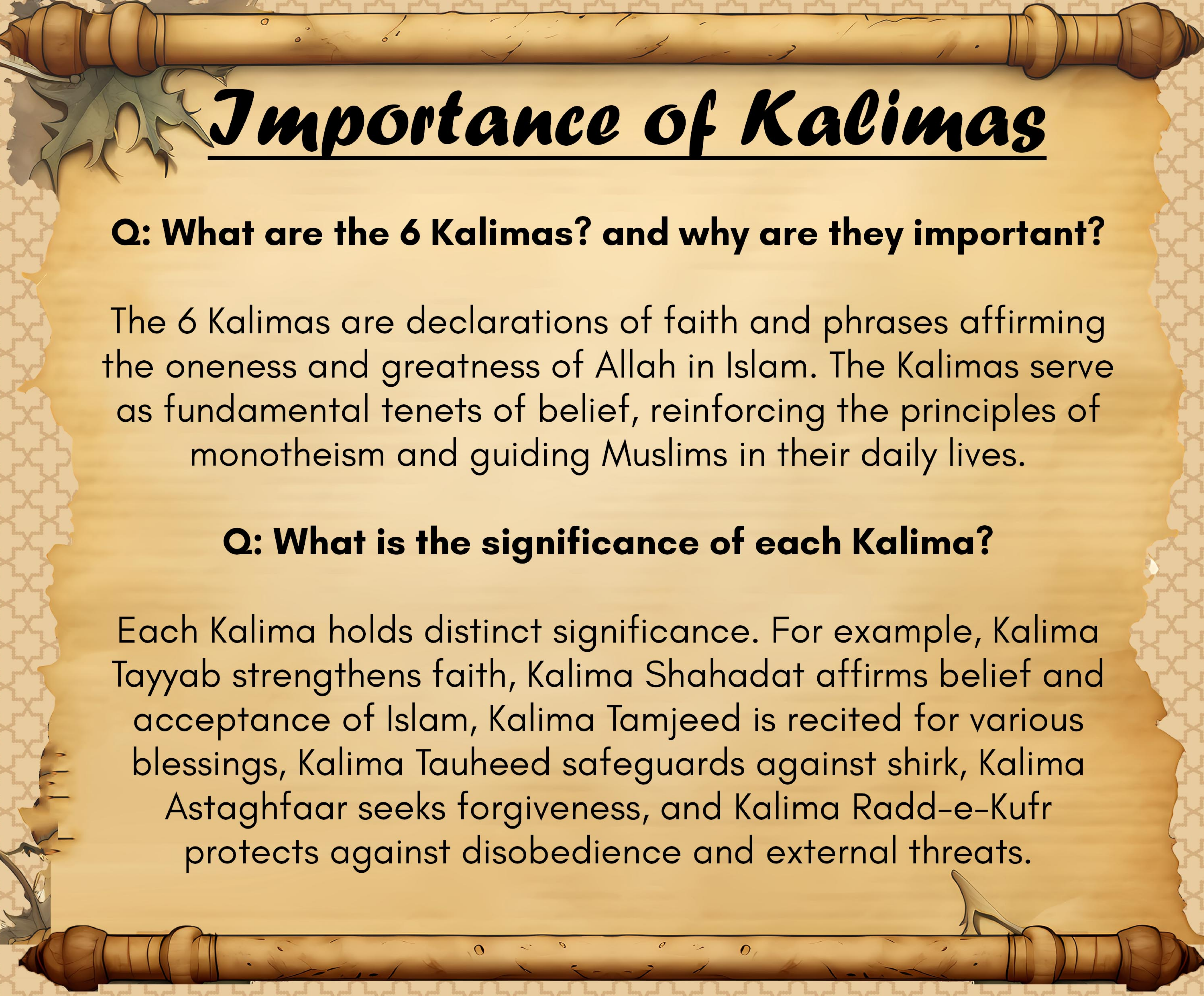

# Importance of Kalimas

**Q: What are the 6 Kalimas? and why are they important?**

The 6 Kalimas are declarations of faith and phrases affirming the oneness and greatness of Allah in Islam. The Kalimas serve as fundamental tenets of belief, reinforcing the principles of monotheism and guiding Muslims in their daily lives.

**Q: What is the significance of each Kalima?**

Each Kalima holds distinct significance. For example, Kalima Tayyab strengthens faith, Kalima Shahadat affirms belief and acceptance of Islam, Kalima Tamjeed is recited for various blessings, Kalima Tauheed safeguards against shirk, Kalima Astaghfaar seeks forgiveness, and Kalima Radd-e-Kufr protects against disobedience and external threats.

Tayyibah (Word of Purity)

Shahadah (Word of Evidence)

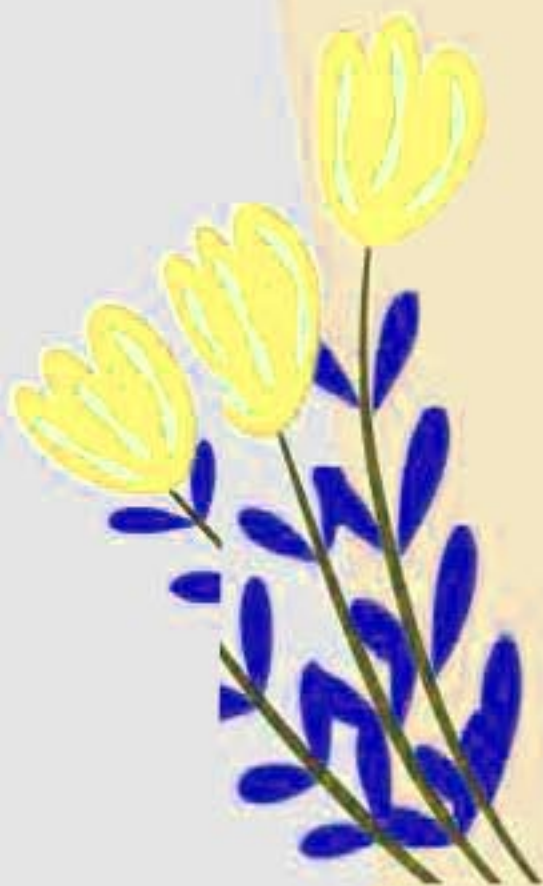
# Fifth Kalma

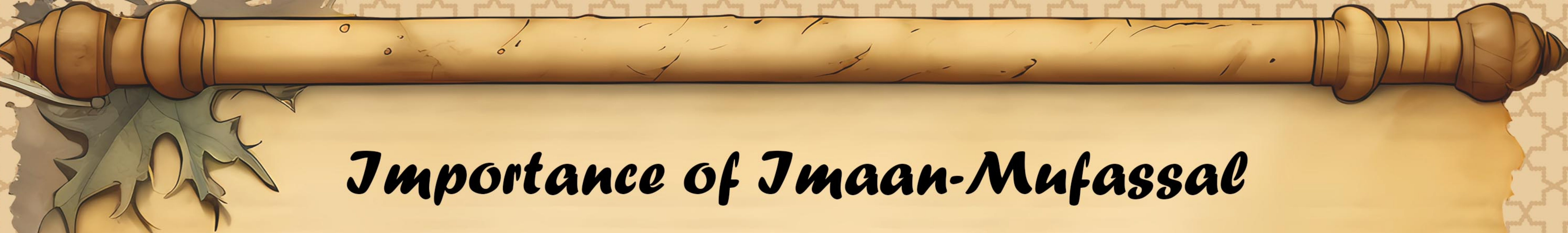

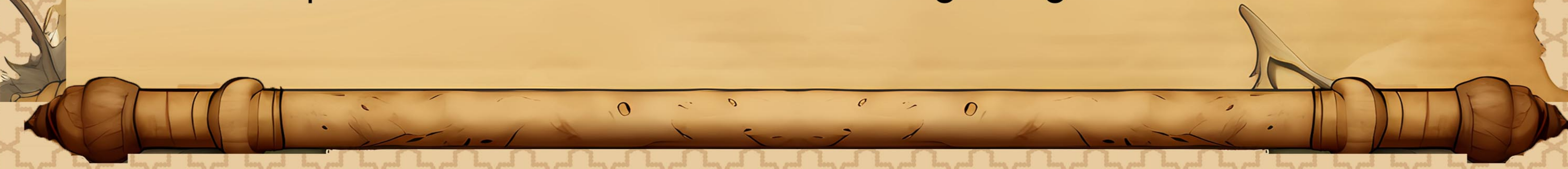


## ***Importance of Imaan-Mufasssal***

The name “Iman-e-Mufasssal” comes from the Arabic word “mufasssal,” which means elaborated or extended. Besides, It alludes to the acceptance of the six pillars of Islam as given in the hadith e Jibreel. These six pillars of faith consist of faith in Allah, angels, revealed divined books, prophets, the Day of Judgement, the Divine plan (Qadr) and life after death.

## ***Importance of Imaan-e-Mujmal***

The importance of Emaan-e-Mujmal lies in the fact that it forms the basis of the Islamic faith. It is the first step towards a deeper understanding of Islam and is the starting point for every Muslim’s spiritual journey. Without Emaan-e-Mujmal, one cannot truly call oneself a Muslim or even begin to understand the beauty and depth of the Islamic faith. Emaan-e-Mujmal provides a framework for living a righteous life.
